- Clean & sanitize all surfaces & toys before/after each use

Keeping Everyone Healthy Upon Reopening

For specific ways you can help at home, please read below and refer to the items in **bold**



Social & Physical Distancing

- Maintain groups of 10 or less, even smaller when possible
- Keep the same staff with same group of children throughout the week
 - o Children from same family will stay together
- Rearrange furniture and play spaces to maintain 6-foot distance
 - Using tape or other visual markers to help children see how to keep distance
- Model/role play social distancing for children

Healthy Habits

Screen for symptoms & temperatures:

- Encourage staff, families, and children to self-screen at home by checking for fevers and symptoms before coming in
 - Anyone with a fever of 100.4°F or higher, may not come to facility
- Temperatures will also be taken upon arrival to facility with a no-touch thermometer
 - Anyone with a fever of 100.4°F or higher may not stay at facility and must be sent home immediately

Handwashing:

- Model & practice proper 20-second handwashing
- Ensure all children and staff wash hands: before & after eating, after coughing or sneezing, after playing outside, after using the restroom
 - Be sure to dry hands thoroughly with paper towels

Other:

- Staff will be required to face masks while on site
- Children are not required to wear masks at this time

Setting Environments Up For Success

Play Times:

- We will choose toys and manipulatives that can be submerged in solution and sanitized
 - Limit amount of sharing by offering more opportunities for individual/solo play
 - No soft or plush toys/materials (stuffed animals, blankets, pillows, etc.)
- Plan activities that do not require close physical contact
- Stagger indoor/outdoor play & adjust schedules to reduce the number of children in same areas
- Designate a tub for toys that need to be cleaned/wiped after use

Meal Times:

- Use more tables & spread children out to ensure adequate spacing
- Utilize IUSD Nutrition Services for lunches
- Lunch items from home must be disposable (items will be disposed of after eating)
- Use disposable items when possible
- Immediately clean tables after meals
- Avoid family or cafeteria style set-up
- We will provide water bottles daily

Cleaning:

- Sanitize handles/sinks before and after each use including in restrooms
- Clean toys and surfaces often and/or after use
 - High-touch areas will be also be cleaned and sanitized every hour

Other

- Teach, model and reinforce healthy habits
- Teach children to sneeze/cough into elbow and use tissue to wipe their nose
- All windows and/or doors will be open during operating hours for maximum ventilation throughout site
- Teach children to use a tissue on handle when flushing toilet
- Eliminate unnecessary personal items brought from home
- Items from the center will not be sent home
- For drop-off and pick-up, please remain in your car and call the center to inform staff of your arrival.
 A designated staff will accompany your child to/from center and sign them in/out manually.
